

**COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH**  
**Your help is needed if this is to work.**

There is a community speed watch group comprising three residents (so far), that have been actively monitoring vehicle speeds along Holt Road through Cross Lanes from time to time. This group was set up in response to the many complaints made by residents, about the excessive speeds through our community.

The speed watch usually detects between 25 and 30 vehicles speeding during a 30 - 45 minutes session. Speeding vehicles are reported on the Go Safe website and the offenders receive warning letters. Repeated offences, (including elsewhere) will lead to prosecution.

For speed monitoring to be effective we need more people to get involved, so that speed watch is carried out on a more regular basis.

If you care about the potential risks to residents on our roads and you are able please volunteer to join a rota.
